## SHOW JUMPING

on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> JULY, 2022 at 9.00 a.m.

at **NEWMARKET ROAD, FORDHAM, CAMBS. CB7 5LL**

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.

**Qualification: 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place.** Qualification does not pass down the line.

**WORLINGTON RIDING CLUB MEMBERS ACHIEVING A CLEAR ROUND IN BOTH SECTIONS IN CLASSES 1 – 7 WILL QUALIFY AT THE RELEVANT HEIGHT FOR MEMBERS ONLY CHAMPIONSHIPS ON 16<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER, 2022**

**CHAMPIONS ON 16<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER WILL RECEIVE £10 CASH, TROPHY, 3 FREE CLASS ENTRIES IN 2023 (worth up to £15) and CHAMPION ROSETTE**

**9.00 a.m. CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - 50 cm (1'6") £4 per round** (lead reins permitted)

**9.30 a.m. CLASS 1 STARTER** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 55cm. (1'9")

**CLASS 2 NURSERY** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 60cm. (2'0")

**CLASS 3 NOVICE** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 70cm. (2'3")

**Class 4 will not start before 11.30a.m.**

**CLASS 4 INTERMEDIATE** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 75cm. (2'6")

**CLASS 5 SMALL OPEN** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 85cm. (2'9")

**CLASS 6 OPEN** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 90cm. (3'0")

**CLASS 7 LARGE OPEN** (for All-comers) Fences approx. 1m. (3'3")

Classes 1 – 7 will be run as Single Phase Competition Table A – both sections. Faults to be accumulated over both sections. Second section against the clock. The competitor will jump the whole course unless they are eliminated. Number of fences: Five to seven fences in each section (minimum 10 fences maximum 13 fences overall). The second section must only comprise of new obstacles not previously used in the first section. The height of the second section should be set higher than those set for the first section.

**Entry Fees: Non-members £9.00 per class. WRC members £5.00**

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. A correctly fitted and secured hat must be worn when mounted, lungeing, leading or loading horses. Hats must carry one of the following current hat standards: PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) or: VG1 01.040 (2014-12) both with BSI kitemark: ASTM F1163 (2004a, 04a onwards) with SEI mark: SNELL E2001 & 2016 with official SNELL label & number or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) with SAI Global mark. At all BRC Area qualifiers & Championships hats must show aqua hat tag.
2. Body protectors are recommended.
3. Correct riding dress must be worn at all times when mounted, whether competing or not, and any competitor will be eliminated if a lost hat is not replaced during a competition. Jackets are required when competing.
4. Whips must be between 45cm and 70 cm.
5. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and does not accept liability for any theft, accident, damage, injury or illness, however caused to horse, owners, riders, spectators, or any other person or property
6. Entry fees cannot be refunded unless a Vet. or Doctor's certificate is produced.
7. The judge's decision in all matters is to be accepted as final.
8. Show Jumping classes will be judged under B.S. rules.
9. Horses and ponies must be 4 years and over.
10. All horses/ponies will be required to assemble in the collecting ring 10 minutes before the time of the class.
11. Any competitor galloping in the exercise area will be asked to withdraw from the show.
12. All dogs must be kept on short leads.
13. **Each competitor is required to pay £2.00 for the First Aid service**
